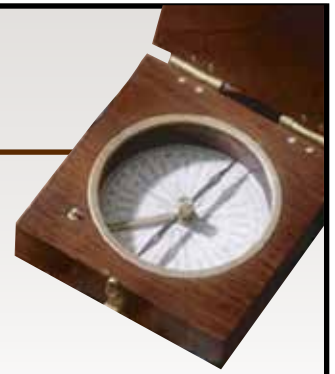


The Productivity Principle of Ambition

Opportunity is seen only by a person who has high ambition. This person is already preparing to ‘make hay’; already an energized worker, a planner and full of ambition.
